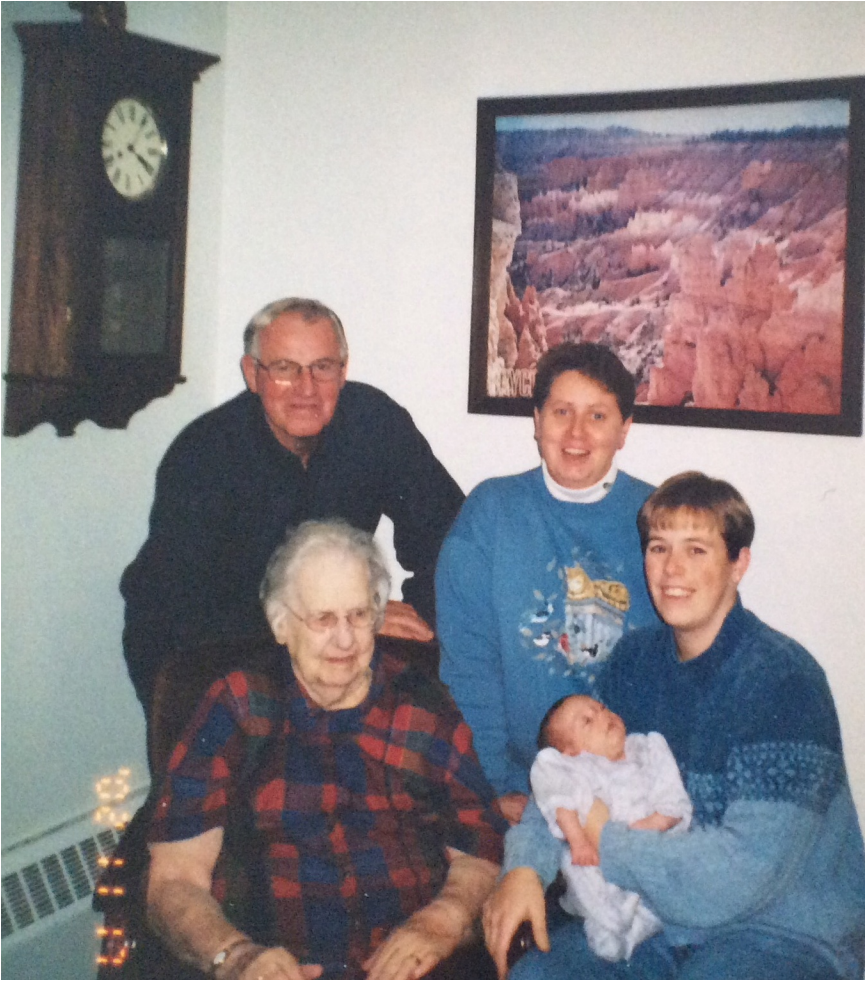
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Five generations of the Fenneman family. Edna Fenneman , Bob Fenneman, Rhonda Marshall , Justine Grummitt and her Mom Mandy.

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A fun day at the toy museum in Dyersville, Iowa.

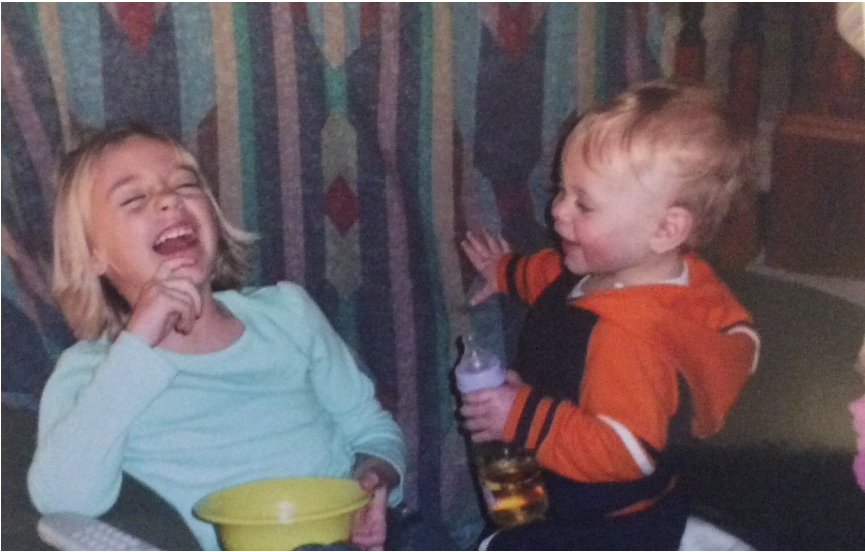


Kyler showed sheep at the local fair and the state fair for several years.
