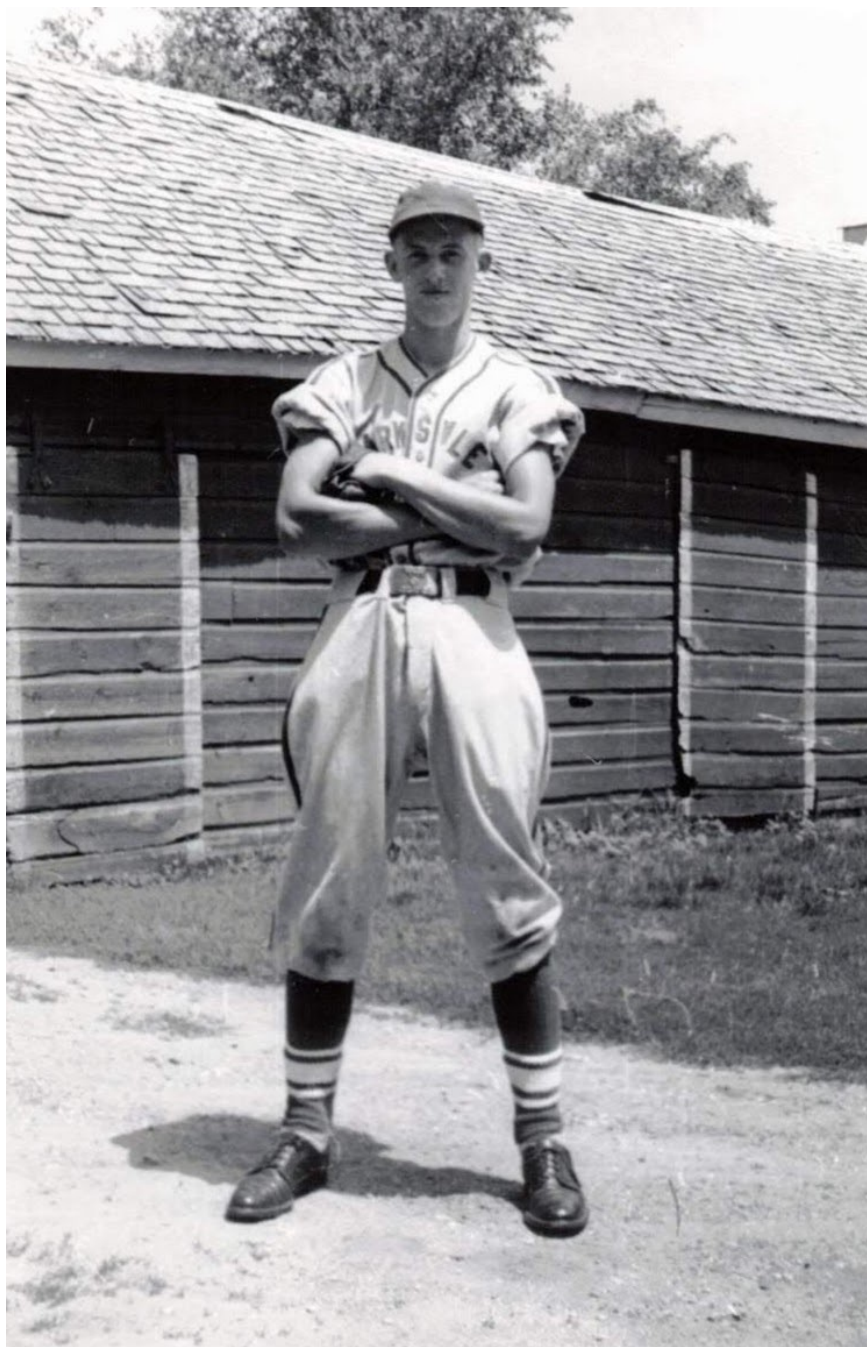
I also played basketball and was on the varsity team. I loved the game and did well.
